GENERAL DIRECTOR, MEDICAL ASSOCIATION OF ATHENS (ISA), (2020-present)

Report to the Board of Directors. Head of all staff. Responsible for the daily operation of the organization, as well as for the two pioneering projects, the Digitization of all services and the Occupational Pension Fund of the Athens Medical Association physicians.

Directed this small size enterprise providing services of medical auditing and consulting mainly to insurance companies. Tenure helped largely in the significant increase of turnover and net earnings.

Directed the hospital of 100 beds and 230 employees. Directly supervised all the administration, financial, informatics and sales development activities, organized and improved procedures, prepared financial statements, conducted various high-level business negotiations, participated in every major decisionmaking of the company. Was the sellers' sole financial advisor in the 17 M euros deal of the sale of a minority stake of the hospital company. Term of office started when the hospital was at a near-extinction point and ended 7 years later with a rise of net profits by 600%.
